

### Extra Activity - "I Am Christ's!"

The focus today is on **"I am Christ's!"** -that means I am never alone & have a place to belong! He is with me and for me and makes me a part of God's family when I accept Him as my Savior & Lord!

Use the following team activity for students to work together to build with cups. Divide campers into groups of four or five and give each group 6 solo cups and one rubber band tool. To begin, have each group arrange their cups like this:



Then as a team, they will need to move the cups from this structure to a pyramid with three cups on bottom, then two cups then one on top.



After their mission is completed ask: "Could you do this all by yourself?"  
"What was the hardest part for you?", "How does it help to have others working with you?"  
Remind campers that when we are Christ's we are not alone! We have Jesus helping us and also we become part of God's family, The Church. We are to live together helping each other as we join God in building His Kingdom.

Have someone read each of the following verses out loud. After each, ask campers what each verse says about how we can work together as the Body of Christ.

Matthew 28:19-20 "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Hebrews 10:24-25 "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near. "

1 Thess. 5:14-22 "And we urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with them all. See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone. Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. ..."
